James and Margaret Bergtold met with the Commission to discuss the low water bridge on Sugar Fork Road off Jaguar road.


Due to the nonstop phone calls and messages regarding damaged bridges and roads, the Commission met with Jerry Mullins, Road and Bridge Foreman. Together they discussed priorities and a plan to get to all damage as soon as possible. With the amount of damage the County received from the recent flood, it will take many hours of work to get to everything. FEMA will meet with the Commission Saturday, May 13 2017, to look at flood damage. This all will be a very long process. The Commission asks that all citizens of the county please be patient while the Road and Bridge department does everything possible to make necessary repairs.

Representatives from Missouri Farmer's Association, David Middleton and Rob Farmer, as well as Jonathan Pierce, met with the Commission. Discussed was a program called Agri-Ready County Designation. This program is no cost to the county and promotes Agriculture business for companies and farmers. An application is required yearly. Commissioner John Bunch made a motion to apply for the Agri-Ready County Designation Program. Commissioner David Holloway seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous.
