**SHOWING DATE**           Mandatory pre-bid site showing at 10:00 a.m., 15 August 2018, at the McDonald Courthouse, Pineville, MO.

**WORK**                        Work is to stabilize & restore eroded banks of the Elk River and Buffalo Creek with rock riprap and fill as described on the associated plans.

**PROJECT SITE**           Indicated in associated plans and project site roadmap.

**CONTRACT**                Contracting of this work is the responsibility of the McDonald County Commission. Submit invoices for Lump Sum payment after construction is completed.

**BID DEADLINE**           Submit bids to the McDonald County Clerk by 1:00 p.m., 22 August 2018.

**BID OPENING**            1:00 p.m., 22 August 2018, at the McDonald County Commission Office in the courthouse in Pineville. The commission retains the right to reject any or all bids.

**BONDING AND INSURANCE**   Proof of at least \$2M liability insurance & \$100k workmen’s compensation must accompany the bid. A performance bond will be required prior to issuing a notice to proceed.

**WORK HOURS**            Maximum six (6) days per week, not exceeding ten (10) hours per day, Monday through Saturday. Overtime pay requirements are established by the contractor within the guidelines of the contract.

**PERFORMANCE TIME**        Notice to proceed will be issued within 10 days of bid opening. All work must be completed prior to **12 December 2018**.

**APPARENT LOW BIDDER**    Apparent low bidders for multiple projects will need to submit a work plan showing how the projects will be accomplished within the allotted time. Low bidders shall also submit an equipment & labor listing to the commission for evaluation prior to letting bid.

<b>QUANTITY VARIATIONS</b>	All payments will be made for lump sum work. No quantity variations allowed.
<b>PAYMENT</b>	Final payment available once project is complete. Request reimbursement from the McDonald County Commission.
<b>WAGES</b>	Davis - Bacon wage rates apply.
<b>SAFETY</b>	Follow OSHA rules regarding on the job safety. It is recommended that at least one employee on site have a current first aid certificate.
<b>POLLUTION CONTROL</b>	All work will be done in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Corps of Engineers General Permit (GP 41). Contractor must maintain a copy of the permit on site at all times.
<b>WORK LIMITS</b>	Keep equipment as close as possible to the work area to minimize damage to private property.
<b>SITE CONDITIONS</b>	Prior to leaving site, areas damaged by equipment during the construction process must be smoothed and seeded by the contractor. Complete seeding according to plan specifications.
<b>TRAFFIC CONTROL</b>	Contractor shall submit a traffic control plan to the county commission for approval prior to construction.
<b>QUALITY CONTROL</b>	Contractor shall have a superintendent present at all times during construction.
<b>CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS</b>	Full-size plans and the US Corps of Engineer General Permit 41 are posted for contractor reference at <a href="http://www.mcdonaldcountygov.com/bids-qualifications.php">http://www.mcdonaldcountygov.com/bids-qualifications.php</a> . It is strongly recommended that each potential bidder review these documents in their entirety prior to submittal of their bid.
