**Deputy Sheriff and Jailer**

*Minimum requirements for employment as Deputy Sheriff are:*

- 1.Be a citizen of the United States.
  - 2.Be at least 21 years of age.
  - 3.Be free of any felony convictions or misdemeanors involving domestic violence or moral turpitude.
  - 4.Be of good character as determined by a thorough background investigation.
  - 5.Be a high school graduate or have passed the General Education Development (GED) Test indicating high school graduation level.
  - 6.Possess a valid driver's license.
  - 7.Be Missouri P.O.S.T. Certified.
  - 8.Be a resident of the State of Missouri (Preferably McDonald County).
- Starting pay for Deputy Sheriff is \$13.46 hourly.

*Minimum requirements for employment as Jailer:*

- 1.Be a citizen of the United States.
  - 2.Be at least 18 years of age.
  - 3.Be free of any felony convictions or misdemeanors involving domestic violence or moral turpitude.
  - 4.Be of good character as determined by a thorough background investigation.
  - 5.Be a high school graduate or have passed the General Education Development (GED) Test indicating high school graduation level.
  - 6.Possess a valid driver's license.
- Starting hourly pay for Jailer position is \$10.10 hour for non-P.O.S.T. certified applicants and \$12.02 hour for P.O.S.T. certified applicants.
